



Whew! I've registered!

...now what happens?

What's the Board doing?

Your board is putting the teams together, readying fields for practice and games, setting up schedules with other regions, and getting all equipment ready for the upcoming season.

When do the coaches get their teams?

Coaches will receive their team rosters on *February 23rd*.

When do the players get called?

You should receive a phone call before *February 28th*. Teams may begin practice on or after *March 2nd*. They will give you all the information you will need on practice times and location. Each coach sets his/her own practice days, time, and location. The practice fields are located throughout Oak Ridge.

It's after February 28th and my child has not been called. What do I do?

Please do not panic if you see teams practicing and your child has not been called. Not all teams begin practice at the same time. Also, some coaches may be out of town. If your child has not been called by *February 28th*, you may call the Registrar at 865-368-0915.

What else does my child need?

The registration fee includes supplemental accident insurance. All players must wear the full AYSO Region 390 uniform (jersey set, shorts, and socks). Uniforms may be purchased at the AYSO office. **Uniform fees are in addition to the registration fee. In addition, players need shoes, a soccer ball (size depends on age), shinguards, and a water bottle.

How often are practices and games?

U06 teams practice once a week and play their games during their practice time. U08-U19 teams practice twice a week (field and times are set by your child's coach). Games will be on Saturdays for 8 weeks. Coaches will distribute exact game schedules when they are finalized.

Refund?

Players who withdraw before *March 2nd* may get a full refund. A fee of \$25.00 will apply after this date. This fee covers payments already made to National AYSO and the City of Oak Ridge. Refunds will be issued for the following reasons: 1) Child is injured and unable to play; or 2) Child has moved out of the region.

Late registration?

Late registration will be considered on a case-by-case basis, if space on a team permits. Late Registration fee is \$15.00 and check is deposited only if the child is registered. Those interested should call 865-368-0915.
