

CENTRAL BAND FEES

FULL YEAR FEE-\$225 CHECKS to CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL

First Semester Fee \$200 (July 21 \$75, August 21 \$50, September 21 \$75)

UNIFORM FEE for Winds/Percussion/Guard of \$25 REQUIRED.

Second Semester Fee (Winds, Concert Percussion) \$25

- All students will receive free/reduced lunch application for further funding assistance. Students on fee waiver will be covered.
- Volunteer services beyond fundraising are an equally necessary component of the band program. All families are needed to help with food for students and receptions, chaperones, work crews, etc., throughout the school year.
- Students who join late will still pay full \$200. New students to Central can have the semester fees prorated.
- There is a \$50 sibling discount for those families with more than one child in the CHS Band.

- STUDENTS ENROLLED IN SPRING SEMESTER BAND WILL HAVE THEIR UNIFORM FEE USED TO PAY SPRING FEE. However, if a student loses a piece of their uniform or returns something in sub-par condition, they will not have their money transferred.

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED STUDENT EXPENSES-DO NOT PAY THESE FEES WITH BAND FEES

Refund Policy: After Band Camp, student fees will not be refunded, unless the student moves school districts, etc. A student dropping band because they do not like it or they decide it is too much work is not an excuse for a refund of fees. We budget our band camp staff, etc. based on the number of students paying fees.

Failure to pay fees on a timely basis may result in my student(s) not being allowed to participate in band activities outside of the classroom. In addition, I understand that am responsible for any additional miscellaneous expenses incurred by my student.
