

## CENTRAL BAND FEES

### **FULL YEAR FEE\*\* \$225 CHECKS to CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL**

First Semester Fee \$200 (June 16 \$75, July 6 \$50, August 15 \$75)

UNIFORM FEE for Winds/Percussion/Guard of \$25 REQUIRED.

Second Semester Fee (Winds, Concert Percussion) \$25

- All students will receive free/reduced lunch application for further funding assistance. Students on fee waiver will be covered.
- Volunteer services beyond fundraising are an equally necessary component of the band program. All families are needed to help with food for students and receptions, chaperones, work crews, etc., throughout the school year.
- Students who join late will still pay full \$200. New students to Central can have the semester fees prorated.
- There is a \$50 sibling discount for those families with more than one child in the CHS Band.
  
- STUDENTS ENROLLED IN SPRING SEMESTER BAND WILL HAVE THEIR UNIFORM FEE USED TO PAY SPRING FEE. However, if a student loses a piece of their uniform or returns something in sub-par condition, they will not have their money transferred.

**Refund Policy:** After Band Camp, student fees will not be refunded, unless the student moves school districts, etc. A student dropping band because they do not like it or they decide it is too much work is not an excuse for a refund of fees. We budget our band camp staff, etc. based on the number of students paying fees.

Failure to pay fees on a timely basis may result in my student(s) not being allowed to participate in band activities outside of the classroom. In addition, I understand that am responsible for any additional miscellaneous expenses incurred by my student.

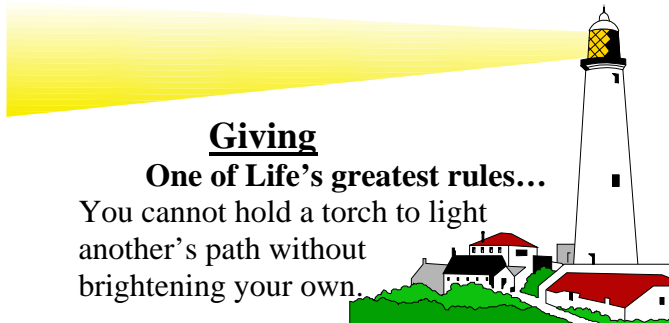

Students traveling with the band to away football games are expected to abide by Knox County, Central High School, and CHS Band rules. Any student not following rules will NOT be allowed to travel with the band or may be subjected to certain disciplinary procedures.

All students will be traveling via school bus to and from football games. Itineraries for the events will be posted prior to departing. Precise itineraries are generally given to students the week of trips and general itineraries are published in the newsletter monthly. Students are expected to arrive ON TIME for all events. Students not arriving on time could be left at Central.

Appropriate dress will be established for the game prior to leaving and posted in the newsletter. Students not prepared will not be allowed to perform. Students will also need money to purchase items from vending machines or concessions during the football games. In some cases, hosts bands provide us with water/sodas. As always, the CHS Band travels with water and sodas. Generally, these are handed out AFTER the bands halftime performance.

Remember, these are SCHOOL events so school rules apply. We are acting as representatives for Central High School and Knoxville. Therefore, appropriate behavior is ALWAYS necessary.
