## Dinner with Boston Globe's Larkin, Oct. 1

Michael Larkin, deputy managing editor for news operations for the Boston Globe, will speak to ETSPJ at a dinner meeting, 6:30 p.m., Oct. 1, at Chesapeake's restaurant on Henley St.

Larkin oversaw the paper's Pulitzer Prize-winning coverage of the child sex abuse scandal within the Roman Catholic Church's Boston diocese. The award praised the Globe for its "courageous, comprehensive coverage of sexual abuse by priests." As a result of the Globe's coverage and resulting outcry from the public, the Church has come under increased scrutiny.

During the media acquisitions of the late 1990s, the New York Times Co. purchased the Globe. The Globe has conducted a number of large investigative series over the years.

Larkin is in Knoxville to speak to journalism classes at the University of Tennessee as the Meeman Visiting Professor at the School of Journalism and Electronic Media.
