

**East Tennessee Woodworkers Guild
Board Meeting June 14, 2010**

Officers and Directors in attendance: Lou Mansur, Ron Clayton, Dan Land, Vic Kaminsky, Wes Loukota, and David Reeves. Also in attendance: Al Hudson and Lee Gossage (newsletter editor).

Lou Mansur called the meeting to order at 6:35 PM at the home of Al Hudson.

Membership / Treasury: Dan Land noted that the Guild currently has 111 members. He also presented the Treasurer's report. The Guild is solvent. Dan also suggested that the Guild consider developing a calendar for 2011. The possibility was suggested of using photos from the Oak Ridge Art Center show for a calendar. This will be discussed at a future board meeting.

Programs: David Reeves reported that Tony Hayzen will provide a Marquetry Program for the September General Meeting. The program for July is still open.

Standards: Ron Clayton reported that there are no new juried members. Much discussion followed on the active involvement/participation in the Guild of future juried members.

Oak Ridge Art Center: Jerry Spady (not available) had done an excellent job of organizing this event. It has been arranged to have the items displayed at the Art Center to be photographed by John Lucas at his studio. John is a professional photographer experienced in taking this type of photographs. To take advantage of this rare opportunity, Ron Clayton presented a motion "The ETWG Board proposes that the Guild proceed with John Lucas taking photos from the Oak Ridge Art Center Show. Each participant who wishes to participate in this opportunity will contribute \$30.00 for John's time. The Guild will pay for all other expenses. (truck rental, insurance, etc.)" Al Hudson seconded the motion. The motion carried. Jerry Spady had agreed to contact each participant in the show before the closing date (June 27) to determine whether the participant wishes to take advantage of the opportunity.

Other Business: Ron Clayton suggested the Board review the possibility of a fall picnic. This will be further discussed at the August Board meeting.

Al Hudson made a motion to adjourn. Second was by Vic Kaminsky. Motion carried. Lou Mansur closed the meeting at 8 PM.
