## Priests' Space

Dear Members of Holy Ghost Parish:

We hope that you take a few minutes after the Masses today to visit with Fr. Patrick Resen under the south side tents obtained for this occasion. Father Patrick has endeared himself to many, many people during his nine months here at Holy Ghost. We wish him well as he assumes his duties as pastor of St. Catherine Laboure parish in Copperhill and as associate pastor at St. Joseph the Worker parish in Madisonville. Our doors are always open to receive folks like you, Father, so please come visit us when you can.

Two "new" priests will be around here - one, Father David Carter, until September 28 - the other, our new associate pastor, Father John Arthur Orr, to arrive later this week. Father Carter, a Knoxville native, is a priest of our diocese who is studying for an advanced degree in Rome. We are grateful to Bishop Stika for allowing Father David to use Holy Ghost as a sort of "home base" as he helps area parishes with summer time supply help.

We enjoyed a short visit with Fr. Ragan Schriver who celebrated the 6:30 am & 8:00 am Masses here this past Friday, July 24, to enable our household of priests to celebrate in Nashville the final vows of several of the St. Cecilia Dominicans. Priests helping priests in service to you in the parishes - just another aspect of observing this year of the priest.

Our Holy Father, Pope Benedict XV, is recuperating from a broken wrist. A vigorous 82, the pope is on his feet as he heals. Pray that he will not suffer too much discomfort.

The refurbished ambo has been well received. It has been lowered some eight inches and an adjustable reading stand helps our proclaimers to see the Word with ease.

Major work was done in the basement of the church this week. Excitement is building already. The finished product, around October 1, will have been worth the wait. In the meantime the ushers will advise you week by week as to which restrooms are available. Thank you for your cooperation as the inconvenience of construction continues.

On Friday, July 16, our Ladies of Charity signed a contract to purchase the Royal Beauty Supply building on West Baxter Ave. When the L'Oreal cooperation also signs, there will begin a 60 day due diligence period to answer the questions/problems any such purchase entails. If the sale is finalized, the Ladies of Charity will move from the Dameron Avenue food pantry and the old Holy Ghost Church building into the "new" building with all their great ministries under one roof.
