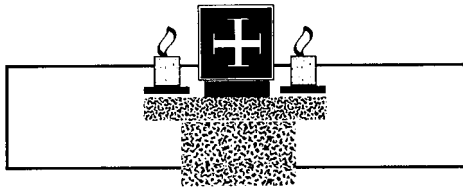
the Eucharistic Prayer may be sung? Even though this is not yet common practice today as it was in the early Church, just the concept of such freedom in tailoring our Masses to fuller and fuller active participation is a great gift to us by the Church). He who sings prays twice.

Our American (U.S.) bishops are meeting in Los Angeles to discuss the English translation of the Mass which has been under consideration for about forty years now. Whatever they decide will be sent to Rome for our Holy Father's approval. All this takes time. As soon as the "final" translation is published for our use at Mass we shall resume to familiarize ourselves with these most important and most sacred matters.

Meanwhile, I continue to beg you by your prayers and by your study of the Church's teachings on the Mass to do the very best job you can do when you come to this most holy and august activity, Sunday in and Sunday out!
