The Braille Trail is based on The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe fantasy by C.S. Lewis. Eight sensory stations along the quarter-mile, wheelchair-accessible Braille trail tell visitors the story of Aslan, the lion. Each station has an exhibit, a large-print sign with Braille, and speaker with pushbutton to activate an audio theatrical recording.
