General:

Each recipient will receive a Lions Hall of Fame lapel pin, a plaque and name permanently engraved on a wall plaque. The wall plaque will hang at the Headquarters Building.

Nominations:

1. Each District Chairman is responsible for the soliciting/completion of nominations and fee from the respective district.
2. Review the nomination(s) for accuracy and forwarding to the Lions Headquarters.
3. Qualifying nominations will be reviewed for guideline compliance, by the Hall of Fame Committee, and selections approved.
4. Each nomination with a \$150.00 fee must be submitted in accordance with the guidelines criteria attached.
 - a. The fee will be used to provide a Lions Hall of Fame Lapel pin, a plaque and name permanently engraved on the wall plaque.
 - b. A maximum of five nominations from each district may be selected the first year.

Selections:

1. Five (5) selections (maximum) may be made for each District the first year; two (2) each year thereafter.
2. The application and \$150.00 fee for those not selected will be returned, and encouraged to submit the following year.

Budget:

The program is to be established and maintained from the application fee.

NOTE: Club must be "In Good Standing" with District and International dues paid up to date for candidate to be considered.

NOTE: To be considered for induction into the MD-12 Tennessee Lions Hall of Fame, the candidate must be an active Lion (exception for health reasons or death).
