

BYLAWS

Article II

Sec. 2. Nonpartisan Policy. The LWVBC may not support or oppose any political party or candidate. Non-board members may participate fully on an individual basis in political activities including running for and holding political office. The president and other board members shall not run for or hold office. If a board member declares for an elective office, the member should resign from the board. Board members shall not undertake any action that will cause them to be identified publicly as supporting any candidate or party. A board member may serve on a public board, commission, or committee; however, the board member does not represent the League in that capacity unless designated a League representative by the League board. The political activities of a spouse or relative of a board member are to be considered as separate and distinct from the activities of the board member.
