Oak Ridge Kennel Club Meeting Minutes: *November, 2008*

As there was no program, President Donna Burchi called our meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. With only 17 members present, there was not a quorum, and the minutes of the October meeting could not be approved. Pat Vogel gave the Treasurer's report; income was from new memberships, tracking lessons and Fall classes. Large expenses during the month were delivery of the agility field dirt, toys for the January agility trial, and purchase of the mic system for agility. A copy of the Treasurer's report is attached, but it was not approved by a quorum. Pat noted that the Vanguard investment account has decreased because of the declining economy, but no action will be taken at this time.

Building: Landscaping Chair Leslie Hardin reported that soil has been purchased (delivery 11/7) for the front bed, with additional to be stockpiled for future use in planting. Remaining funds total \$449; Leslie asked that another name be added to the checking account used specifically for landscaping funds, and Treasurer Pat Vogel will be added. Planned shrubs along the fence might need to be re-thought as parking needs increase. Building Chair Robert Pless reported that the soil for the agility field has been spread and is nearly ready for delivery of the sod. Flood lights have been installed on corners of the bathroom building, and all street lights are working to provide additional safe lighting. Tim Snow is purchasing/cutting paneling to go around the windows. Next work days are 11/14-15 to lay sod, paint paneling, and clean the buildings and windows. Much help is needed, and the new sod will need to be protected from foot traffic by additional fencing. The fencing from building to building will be purchased once the agility trial receipts are in the checking account. A chairperson is needed for Grounds Maintenance to coordinate mowing, weed eating, and other tasks related to maintaining the exterior of the property on a weekly/monthly basis. Nell Johnson agreed that she would take that position and make calls to be sure that the property stays tidy.

Agility: Since we run two rings each of the three trial days, many volunteers are needed for agility in January. Mary Jo Steger outlined the various tasks, many of which require no previous skill. A hospitality person (drinks for workers, pick up judge) and ribbon attendee are also needed. All volunteers receive lunch. An additional request will be put in the Woofers, and it is important that everyone supports this fun and income-producing venture.

Show: Show Chair Donna Burchi discussed trophies for the May show. This year, daily trophies will include "Bred-by" instead of puppy awards, two Juniors awards for Conformation (Chairs Carol Jeffrey and Missy Neal). The club will also provide trophies for High in Trial and High Combined for Obedience (Chairs Bonnie Herrell and Linda Hargis), and rally trophies from individuals will be awarded (Rally Chair Debbie Echols). Club members can purchase trophies from ORKC if they don't know what to get or don't have time to shop. The trophy list is due to Onofrio on 12/31 for inclusion in the Premium List, so timely signup is important - see the form in the November Woofers

Insurance: There was discussion about our insurance coverage (continue with December payment?, and obtain additional for buildings and officers), but Jeff Banta, who is looking into that issue, was not present.

Old Business: None

New Business: There was a discussion about additional uses for our buildings (microchip, eye, and heart clinics, as well as conformation seminars by noted individuals). Mary Jo reported that AKC is planning new non-regular Obedience classes that competitors will need to learn about. Speakers for those clinics would be popular this coming year. Landscaping Chair Leslie Hardin asked guidance in storing extra soil. It was decided that it should be placed outside the gate on the right near the wooded area. Bob Bardorf graciously offered his lovely home for the Christmas Party (instead of the Wildcat Den as published in the Woofers). The time remains the same at 6:00 p.m., meat and drinks provided.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.

Baby, What a Start!

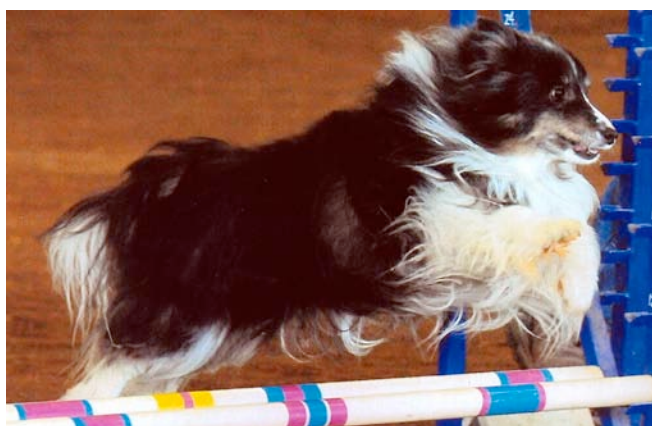

Another Dog Dies After Visit to West Knoxville Groomer

Knoxville attorney Tom Ramsey says his family lost their healthy, five-year old Beagle, "Moxie," after taking her to get groomed at Happy Tails the Tuesday before Thanksgiving. When their son went to go pick her up, the owner, Erik Webb, came running out with Moxie in his arms and told their son to follow him to his father's vet office, Rocky Hill Animal Clinic.

The Ramseys say Dr. Webb pronounced Moxie dead.

Webb claims Moxie died of a seizure. However, the Ramseys weren't satisfied with that conclusion and took Moxie to their vet. After a necropsy was performed at UT, results show she died from heat exhaustion and blunt trauma. Moxie had three broken ribs and a lacerated liver which caused her to bleed to death.

Happy Tails currently has 10 complaints against it with the Better Business Bureau and has an unsatisfactory record. Plus, there are three lawsuits filed against Happy Tails for negligence regarding the deaths of other animals within the past three years.

Webb says Moxie's death was an accident, and he claims the dog tried to attack him and he threw it off. That's when he says her ribs were cracked. Webb says he didn't call the Ramseys because he was so busy trying to get the dog off of him. He says there are slight marks on him from the attack. He adds that he doesn't know why the necropsy would show Moxie had heat exhaustion.

This month's tip: According to the AVMA (American Veterinary Medical Association of America), mistletoe leaves and berries are highly toxic, holly berries and leaves and moderately toxic and poinsettias have a low toxicity. Unlike what many of us have been told and passed along, large quantities of poinsettias would have to be ingested to have an effect on people or pets. I hope everyone has a wonderful Christmas and New Year with their families and pets! And don't forget - November is the #1 month to plant woody plants but as blessed East Tennesseans, we can still plant as long as the ground is not frozen. So, happy planting, too!
