Any funds raised will be managed or invested to result in interest income for the ORSC without constraining the progress of the project. The City, through Josh Collins, will provide monthly status of the funds to the Project Team, plus provide an annual accounting of income and distributions.


#### 4. DECISION MAKING


The Project Team will make decisions with respect to the planning, design, general development, and construction of the ORSC, and will be led by a project manager to coordinate the effort. The designated project manager is Douglas W. Turner of Oak Ridge, TN. The project manager and Project Team will recruit volunteers, solicit contributions, and take other actions to facilitate completion of the ORSC. Any commitment of significant funds (greater than \$5,000) from any of the designated accounts for the project will require written approval of the leaders or designees of each of the Parties. The Project Team will present a Project Plan for a phase or portion of the project to each of the Parties. Upon approval of each phase or portion of the ORSC by the Parties, the Project Team can proceed with the respective phase. Any changes to the respective phase or related work exceeding \$5,000 will require further approval of the Parties.

#### 5. FUTURE USE AND MAINTENANCE

The property belongs to the City of Oak Ridge. After the completion of the project, R&P will be responsible for regular maintenance. The Parties that provide funding for the ORSC will have priority for use of the facilities, and will work together in scheduling the use of the facilities. The Parties will work together to plan major events such as soccer tournaments for full use of the ORSC, and to fund future improvements to the ORSC and other soccer facilities in the City of Oak Ridge.
