ENTRY FEES: \$25.00 for 1st entry of each dog per day. **\$22.00** for 2nd entry of same dog per day except puppies 6-12 mos. and BBE **\$20.00**. Sweepstakes **entry 1s \$15.00** and dog must be entered in a regular class. Enter Sweepstakes in Additional Classes

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS: make fees payable in U.S. Funds.

A RECORDING/ENTRY FEE of \$.50 and 3.00 event fee and will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. This event/entry fee is collected by the show-giving club and paid to the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the evenyentry fee is collected on the 1st entry only. [AKC rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.] This recording/entry fee is included in the fee amount.

MAKE ALL CHECKS & MONEY ORDERS payable to SMOKY MOUNTAINS BULLDOG CLUB. The Show Chairperson assumes NO responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Credit cards are not accepted as payment. Entry fees must be paid prior to show time or armband numbers will not be issued.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES is 12:00 p.m., Wednesday, Aug. 4, 2010, at the Show Secretary's address after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable. Unsigned entries are not accepted.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS: Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

RETURNED CHECKS and POST-DATED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should the exhibitor not receive such acknowledgement within a reasonable time, please contact Grant Howard

NOTE: Effective for all shows held after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the regular conformation judging at the show. (Chapter 11, Sec. 6, AKC Rules)

SHOW HOURS: Doors will open at 5:00 pm. and Judging begins at 7:00 EST on Friday. Doors open at 8:00 a.m. and Judging begins at 9:00 a.m., EST on Saturday. Doors open at 7:00 a.m. and Judging begins at 8:00 a.m., EST Sunday; Specialty judging will begin 15 minutes after Sweepstakes ends on Saturday. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its classes are called to be judged. All dogs are required to enter the ring in numerical order. Dogs not required for further judging may go.

THERE ARE 2 CRATE / GROOMING AREAS close to the show site room. Dogs cannot be left there overnight.. The use of private exercise pens will be governed by the Show Committee on the day of the show. Grooming dogs in areas other than as designated is not permitted: this will be strictly enforced.

SOFT-SIDED CRATES must be kept in the grooming areas. For the protection and safety of exhibitors, spectators and entries, soft-sided crates will be monitored in the show building and should not be left unattended. **NO CRATING AT RINGSIDE.**

THERE WILL BE NO SPACE provided for unentered dogs at this show.

ALL TROPHIES, PRIZES, RIBBONS must be claimed the day of the show. No awards will be mailed. Unclaimed awards will revert to SMBC's general trophy inventory one hour after judging is completed.

SMBC RESERVES THE RIGHT to substitute a prize or trophy of equal or greater value if any prize listed or described becomes unavailable.

A RAMP may be used by the judge at his/her discretion.

ALL VIDEOTAPING during the shows requires Club permission. **SMBC retains all rights** to photograph +/or videotape, +/or televise, +/or reproduce these events in any way, now and in the future.

THE SMOKY MOUNTAINS BULLDOG CLUB and SMOKY SHADOWS MOTEL & CONFERENCE CENTER assume **NO RESPONSIBILITY** for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, dogs, property, or children not under control of parents or guardians. Each dog at this show is in the care and control of his owner +/or handler during the time the dog is on show premises.

IN THE EVENT A MOTOR VEHICLE MUST BE ENTERED TO RESCUE A DOG FROM OVERHEATING OR SUFFOCATION DUE TO IMPROPER VENTILATION, all persons attending this show hereby waive any claims for damages against The SMBC or its members.

SMBC asks that owners/handlers pick up after their dogs.

ALL DOGS must be held on a leash or confined to their crates, except when being judged.

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 11, AKC RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS: "Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The AKC Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. There shall be no benching, nor offering for sale or breeding, nor any displaying of unentered dogs." The SMBC will strictly enforce this rule. Violators will be subject to action by the Event Committee and if found in violation, suspension of AKC privileges may be recommended.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be made in the ring, before the judging of the breed is over. The SMBC disclaim liability for any cash prizes after judging is over.

IT IS EXPECTED that exhibitors follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

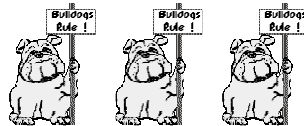

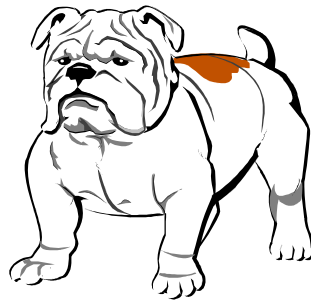

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim, and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering, your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
