Many of Sandy's MPs were earned playing Knockouts with teammates Joy Panella, **Jo Kelly** and **Bob Way**. The journey ended August 25th, 2011 at a STaC game pot-luck luncheon at the Pinkerton's home while playing with Gary Penix. They garnered enough silver points to push her over the top and earn her Life Master. What a thrill to have this happen at our own home club. By the way, she found out later that day that her only daughter **Cynthia** became engaged to **Ron Branch** at almost the same time as she earned her Life Master. Another big part of Sandy's life is playing the organ for church services at St. Patrick's. She resides in Morristown, TN with her husband **Richard** who also belongs to ACBL. Although he doesn't play very often, he is almost as big a supporter of our club as Sandy who is our club treasurer and cookie maker *par excellence*. Her warm smile and pleasant ways brighten up our games.

Our Morristown Club is introducing three more new members this quarter:

First, **Hedda O'Donovan**. Her introduction to bridge happened while living in Caracas Venezuela in 1969. She was in her early twenties and spending a weekend on the beach with friends who were avid bridge players. Sandy Carter was lucky enough to start learning bridge in high school and now has been at the game for over fifty

years. Even so, she still continues to try new gadgets to improve her game. For over thirty years she belonged to a three table duplicate bridge group which had several life masters. They were willing to coach her and take her other places to play, the largest was at Bowling Green University in Ohio. When she and her husband retired to Baneberry, TN her partner moved to Michigan and she thought that would be a longish commute for a game of bridge. However, as luck would have it, Janice Hobson also moved to Baneberry and together they found their way to our Morristown Club and promptly joined ACBL. Her warmth and friendliness are a welcome addition to our group.

She immediately found a Baneberry bridge group and became their substitute. Once Janice retired, she and Sandy Carter teamed up and began coming to our group. She loves the game and enjoys the people who make up the Morristown Bridge Club and we can readily say the same about her.

How You Can Help Build Youth Bridge

As a member of the Unit's Membership Committee. I analyzed data from the ACBL Membership office (it's now about two months old). The data indicate that 74.5% of ACBL members is 65 or older. Only 0.8% is 24 or younger.

That is for us a great challenge. If this game that we enjoy so much is to be around much longer, many of us will have to "pitch in" to fill the member numbers gap.

Several Unit members have "stepped up" and tried to interest younger players through programs they have started. Alas, failure has outranked success.

Fortunately there are positive stories of recent efforts to attract youth to duplicate and the ACBL. From these experiences come helpful guidelines for getting started and following through with junior bridge. These guidelines are available on a number of web sites, but only a few of these offer comprehensive, easy to follow information. And unless you carry a laptop around, you'll need to download and print lots of articles and stories to study and pass around to your friends and co-sponsors of nascent junior bridge programs.

To help us learn about successful techniques from well-known programs such as "Atlanta Junior Bridge", a "Workshop for Youth Bridge" is being held on April 17, 2010 at the Gatlinburg Regional. Participation is free of charge, open to anybody, and there will be plenty of opportunity to ask questions and learn from others. A free literature packet also will be provided. Financial support is coming from District 7 and others.

Our hope is to equip each of us who want to promote duplicate youth bridge with the tools and knowledge to start a successful program.
